

CLEAN THESE OFTEN:

- Phones, walkie talkies, TV remotes
- Touchscreens, computer keyboards, filing cabinets
- EFTPOS machines



ASSIGN EQUIPMENT TO SPECIFIC RESIDENTS IF POSSIBLE. IF NOT, CLEAN THESE BETWEEN EACH RESIDENT'S USE:

- Shower chairs, hoists and slings, walking frames, wheelchairs
- Gait belts and slide sheets
- Blood pressure cuffs, stethoscopes, oximeters
- Robotic pets, stuffed toys and dolls
- Board games and jigsaw puzzles
- Objects from sensory rooms



DON'T SHARE

THESE PERSONAL CARE ITEMS BETWEEN RESIDENTS:

- Nail varnish, make-up, brushes, combs
- Skin care products (eg, face creams)
- Clothing, footwear

- Treatments for fleas, ticks and worms, and vaccinations should be up to date
- The animal should be clean with nails trimmed
- Wash your own and the resident's hands after handling any pet
- Discourage animal 'kisses'
