## Free one-day workshop 2021

**An opportunity for health leaders to explore contemporary challenges and opportunities for quality and safety in the health and disability system in Aotearoa**

The Health Quality & Safety Commission is running an inaugural systems leadership for quality and safety programme for senior health leaders. The programme consists of an in-person one-day workshop and four follow-on Zoom sessions.

The one-day workshop will be held in three locations in April 2021, and will include sessions on:

- Te Tiriti o Waitangi and the case for equity
- consumer engagement and leadership
- systems thinking and complexity
- measurement for quality
- leading in complexity.
