The Health Quality & Safety Commission is running a four-month **Improving together: Improvers** programme for the primary care sector. This includes consumers and providers, with an emphasis on general practice teams, pharmacies and Māori health providers.

The programme aims to provide participants with a basic knowledge of quality improvement and safety science, and an understanding of simple quality and safety tools.

The programme will support the primary care sector to:

- build a culture of patient safety and quality improvement
- meet current and future consumer needs
- improve teamwork.

The programme will be delivered via nine two-hourly Zoom sessions (4–6pm).
