



# Creating safe spaces for engagement

- Te Ao Māori framework
- Whakawhanaungatanga
  - the process of establishing relationships
  - creating connections with people and places are foundational to everything we do
- Creating le vā
  - a spatial way of conceiving the secular and spiritual dimensions of relationships and relational order, that facilitates both personal and collective well-being (Anae, 2007)
- Teu le vā
  - the ‘valuing’, ‘nurturing’ and ‘looking after’ of these relationships to achieve optimal outcomes for all stakeholders (Anae, 2007)



# Creating safe spaces for engagement

- Involve consumers and whānau from the beginning
  - **are** key stakeholders
  - **must** be at the forefront
  - **need** to be involved from the beginning
  - hold the **knowledge and solutions**
- Find out their preferences:
  - meet kanohi ki te kanohi
  - suitable timing/ allow for flexibility
  - meet in an environment of their choice
  - consider whether further support is required
- Listen to understand
  - be open minded
  - be honest and transparent
  - be patient and compassionate

**Your priorities and timelines  
are not the same as theirs**

- Who to approach
  - use your established networks
- How to grow and create new connections
  - whakawhanaungatanga
  - create the vā
  - use your established networks
  - reach out to forums
