Interested in improving the quality of aged residential care services? Then come to the Health Quality & Safety Commission's upcoming free regional workshops to learn, share and connect with others in this sector.

The half-day workshops will give you a chance to have input into quality improvement in aged residential care and inform how the Commission adds value in this area.

There will also be a best practice sharing session on care planning and the use of interRAI by Dr Michal Boyd. Michal will share the latest clinical research on assessing frailty and the high-risk indicators and talk about her work in the development of an advanced frailty care guide.

At the workshops, we would like to collect stories and examples of practice that are working well in your region to improve care. These will be shared at other workshops.
