

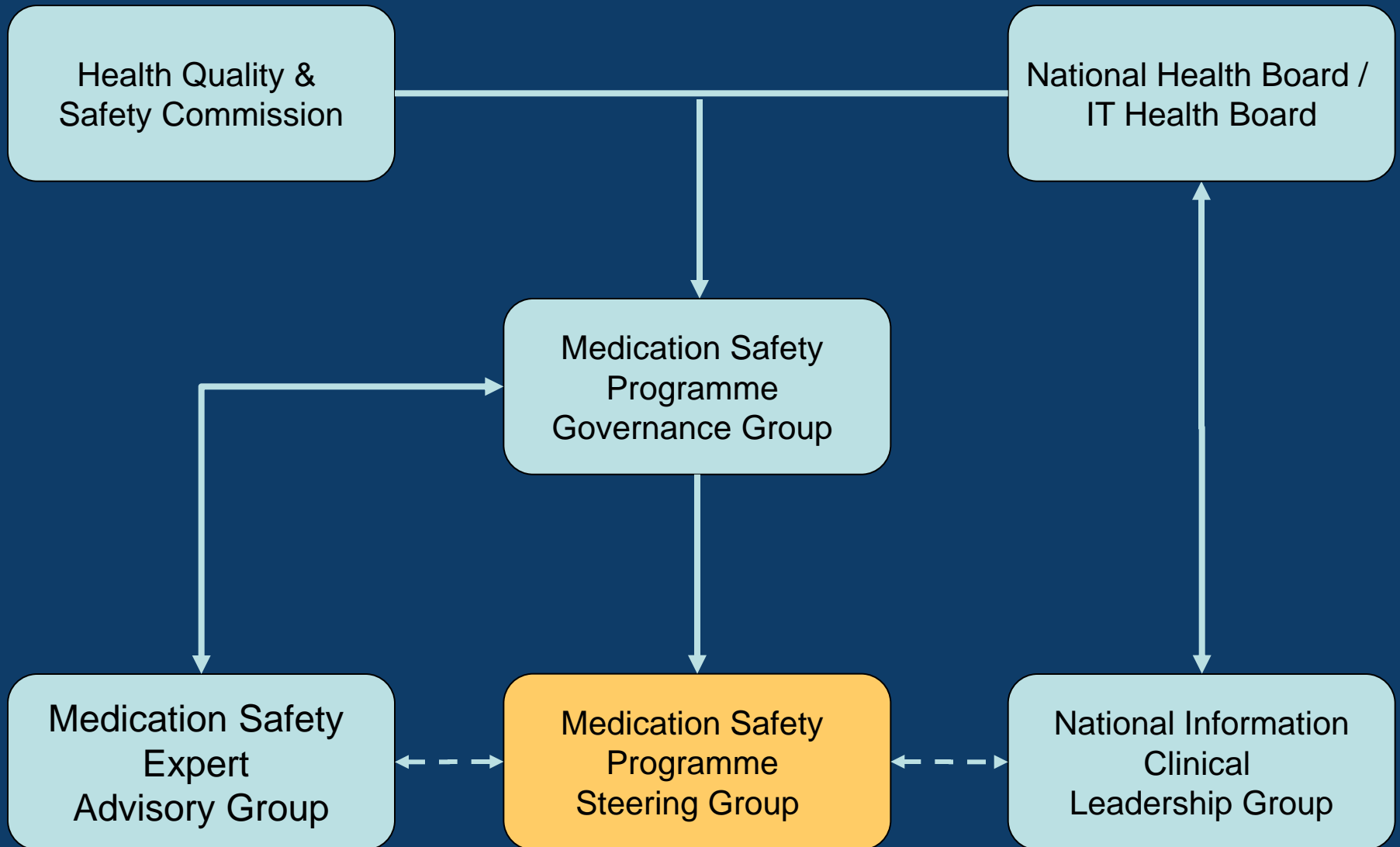

# Status

- Paper-based Medicines Reconciliation & National Adult Medication Chart – rolling out
- Hospital eMedicines Reconciliation – 3 x DHBs, Meds on discharge
- Hospital eMedication Charting – 1 x DHB, 3 more in pipeline
- NZ Universal List of Medicines – released, various vendors using
- NZ Medicines Formulary – provider selected, implementation starting
- NZ ePrescription Service – pre-trial completing, trial locations identified, national rollout June 2011, iterative approach, some vendor challenges
- Other projects (medication component only)
  - Transfer of Care (eReferrals) – Hutt Valley, Northern Region
  - Transfer of Care (eDischarges) – PDF in eDS message, + CDA + import POC + spec for all by Oct, CMDHB eDS processes as template for others?
  - Clinical Data Repositories / Shard Care Records (Regional) – south & north
  - Pharmacy (Regional) – Midland underway, Central looking at options
  - Information Governance Framework (National) – discussion document released
  - Primary care Medicine Reconciliation – Patients First
  - Prescribing system changes – Medtech, PHARMAC, Patients First
  - GP2GP – Patients First
