1. Element 5 – Staff education: not included in this template – an annual audit of this process measure is suggested.
2. The individual care bundle outcome, balancing and process measures with exclusions are outlined overleaf – refer to the uncontrolled pain care bundle for full information.
3. NA: not applicable - an exclusion applies.
4. Totals: add up the total number for each measure; record as total number/number of patients audited.

UCP outcome measure: patients with uncontrolled pain: ≥ 2 consecutive pain scores of $\geq 7/10$ (or $\geq 3/5$) in 24 hours

UCP balancing measures: patients administered an opioid who develop: OIC bowels not open for > 3 days, OIVI respiratory rate 8–10 and sedation score ≥ 2 (using the sedation scale in the how to guide)

Exclusions: Nil

Population: Age 12 years and over admitted to a hospital inpatient area

Process measures	Exclusion
Provide patient with information about opioid use for optimum pain management	The patient is not in a state to receive or understand the information and the family/whānau is unavailable
Does the opioid prescription match the pain medication dosing guidelines for the indication?	A patient with a clinical condition not explicitly covered by the guidelines
Patient prescribed an opioid who has had pain behaviours/indicators monitored and documented according to local guidelines and methods	Nil
Patient offered regular analgesia, and additional analgesia when pain is not relieved (with attention to patient safety as well as comfort)	Patients who refuse an intervention
