Become an advance care planning ambassador.

- Start having conversations as soon as possible.
- Identify consumers who would benefit from advance care planning.
- Initiate discussions and provide resources.
- Document in clinical notes that conversations have taken place and share this information with relevant health professionals that may be able to follow up.
- Help consumers to complete an advance care plan if that is their wish.
- Seek support from colleagues experienced in advance care planning for the more challenging conversations.
- Promote advance care planning and use the resources on the website: www.myacp.org.nz
- Get involved in local awareness raising campaigns.
- Talk to your colleagues about advance care planning and encourage them to complete the online modules available on the national website under the 'health professionals' tab.
