The Health Quality & Safety Commission is running a four-month Improving together: Improvers programme for the primary care sector. This includes consumers and providers, with an emphasis on general practice teams, pharmacies and Māori health providers.

The programme aims to provide participants with a basic knowledge of quality improvement and safety science, and an understanding of simple quality and safety tools.

The programme will support the primary care sector to:

- build a culture of patient safety and quality improvement
- meet current and future consumer needs
- improve teamwork.

The programme will be delivered via nine two-hourly Zoom sessions (4–6pm). The first session is 6 September 2021. (See registration page for all session times and dates.)
