Disaster prevention tips

- 1. Increase Awareness of HH
- 2. Increase Accessibility and acceptability of product
- 3. Increased Auditing

Increase awareness by...

- Articles and posters
- Medical HOD ownership



- Quality- Awards for consistency above 80% & improvement
- Ward ownership
- Sequencing training Scenarios
- Target HH E Learning

HH accessibility and acceptability

- Spot audits of end of beds in each area
- hed bracket availability
- Refine product
- Ensure supply
- Teach better bed bracket mounting





Increased auditing

- Run twice yearly and well publicised auditor study days
- Employ auditor for 1 day per week (Doing baseline and then national audit)
- Get areas to send senior nurses for auditing training
